Registration: Please fill out form and return to Office.

Participation: As a member of the Church, you are accepting the responsibility of weekly worship as well as supporting God's work here through giving of yourself, your time and talents, and a worthy Sunday offering to show your love for God and your gratitude for His many favors.

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONE: One half-hour prior to weekend Mass or by request/appointment.

BAPTISM/BATTESIMO: Preparation is required for the reception of the sacrament. Parents are encouraged to call the Rectory and set up an appointment before the birth of their child.

MATRIMONY/MATRIMONIO: Arrangements should be made at least six or more months in advance. A marriage preparation program is required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK/INFERMI: In cases of emergencies, please call anytime. Please notify the Parish Office for Communion calls to the sick, shut-ins. Due to privacy laws, if parishioners wish to be visited in the hospital, they should contact the Parish Office directly and give the information regarding the hospitalization. **If you are scheduled for surgeries or other medical procedures**, please contact the Parish Office in advance so that a priest can administer Anointing of the Sick prior to the procedure.

One of the most important aspects a parish must have to survive is a strong religious education program. **St. John's Parish** classes started **September 15th** in the secretary's office on the second floor. **Grandchildren are**

welcome if the grandparents are registered in the parish. Non-Catholic children are also invited. Class begins immediately following the **9:30 a.m. Sunday Mass** and will last **45 minutes**. ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS: The process in which adults enter the **Roman Catholic Church** is known as **OCIA**, "The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults." **Who is eligible for this process?**

The Unbaptized. The primary focus of the **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults** is on those who are not already **Christian** and have had little or no religious education.

Baptized but un-catechized are those who have been baptized in the **Roman Catholic Church** but need further catechetical instruction to celebrate the **Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist.**

Those Seeking Full Communion with the Catholic Church are baptized, practicing **Christians** from another **Christian Tradition** who seek entry, or full communion with the **Roman Catholic Church.**

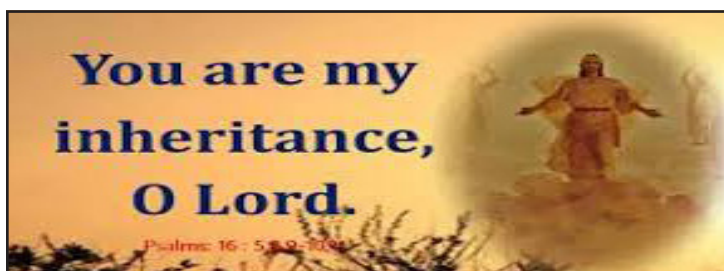

MAJOR RELICS OF ST. THOMAS AQUINAS: The major first-class relics of **St. Thomas Aquinas** (which includes the relic of his skull) will be available for public veneration at **St. Patrick Church, 280 N. Grant Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43215, on December 7-8, 2024.** This is the first time that **St. Thomas'** major relics will tour the **United States**, through an arrangement between the **Dominican Province of Toulouse, France, and the Dominican Province of St. Joseph (Eastern U.S.A.)**. The relic tour is in commemoration of the **Triple Jubilee of St. Thomas Aquinas: the 700th anniversary** of his canonization in **2023**, the **750th anniversary** of his death in **2024**, and the **800th anniversary** of his birth in **2025**.

THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER IS THE MONTH OF ALL SOULS: This is a time to pray for the souls of those who have died, especially the souls in **Purgatory**. Just as we hope that one day, people will pray for us after we have died, so, too, we should pray daily for those who have gone before us.
