#### **ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS:**

The process in which adults enter the **Roman Catholic Church** is known as **OCIA**, "**The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults**." Who is eligible for this process?

<u>The Unbaptized.</u> The primary focus of the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is on those who are not already Christian and have had little or no religious education.

Baptized, but un-catechized are those who have been baptized in the Roman Catholic Church, but need further catechetical instruction to celebrate the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist. Those Seeking Full Communion with the Catholic Church are baptized, practicing Christians from another Christian Tradition who seek entry, or full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

## AROUND US

**LITURGICAL CALENDAR:** The first **24 days** of **December** fall during the liturgical season known as <u>Advent</u> and are represented by the liturgical color purple – a symbol of penance, mortification and the sorrow of a contrite heart. The remaining days of **December** mark the beginning of the <u>Christmas</u> season. The liturgical color changes to white or gold – a symbol of joy, purity, and innocence. The month of **December** is dedicated to the **Immaculate Conception**.

# YOU ARE INVITED TO PRAY FOR THE HOLY FATHER'S INTENTIONS FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2024

For Pilgrims of Hope, we pray that this Jubilee Year strengthens our faith, helping us to recognize the Risen Christ in our daily lives and that it may transform us into pilgrims of Christian hope.



FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT: On the fourth Sunday of Advent, we light the final purple candle to mark the final week of prayer and penance as we wait for the birth of our Savior. This final candle, the "Angel's Candle," symbolizes

peace. It reminds us of the message of the angels: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."

CHRISTMAS: Today, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Nativity the Lord, the Birth of Jesus Christ, and the First Day in the Octave of Christmas. Through Advent, the Church longed ardently for the coming of our Savior. Today, she celebrates His birth with unrestrained joy. "The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us." The Son of God became man to give us a share in that divine life which is eternally His in the Blessed Trinity. Christmastime begins on December 24 with the first Vespers of the feast and ends on the feast of the Baptism of Christ. White vestments reappear in our churches as a sign of joy.



PRAYER: O God, who have made this most sacred night radiant with the splendor of the true light, grant, we pray, that we, who have known the mysteries

of His light on earth, may also delight in His gladness in heaven. Who lives and reigns with You in unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen
