**ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS:**

The process in which adults enter the **Roman Catholic Church** is known as **OCIA**, "The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults." Who is eligible for this process?

**The Unbaptized.** The primary focus of the **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults** is on those who are not already **Christian** and have had little or no religious education.

**Baptized, but un-catechized** are those who have been baptized in the **Roman Catholic Church**, but need further catechetical instruction to celebrate the **Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist.** **Those Seeking Full Communion with the Catholic Church** are baptized, practicing **Christians** from another **Christian Tradition** who seek entry, or full communion with the **Roman Catholic Church.**


